P and C Update

At the March meeting representatives from Telstra presented the results of the RF EME Survey Report of

the measurement of emissions from the newly constructed Mobile Phone Base Station adjacent to the School. In summary, all measured RF EME levels are below the ARPANSA RPS3 General Public Exposure Limit. If you would like to see a full copy of the report please ask Mrs Herrmann for one. Telstra have committed to coming back every three years to do follow up measurements.

We also discussed the School Uniform policy and the inclusion of baseball style caps as part of the school uniform. It was unanimously voted not to allow the caps to be official school uniform and for the policy to remain having broad brimmed hats only. The new sports shorts were also presented, they are similar material to the microfibre track pants and will be available soon for purchase.
